A collaboration between:

- **You** or your company / organization / association interested in hosting a volunteer.
- **Us** the Bureau International Jeunesse (BIJ) a public service of the French-speaking Community of Belgium supporting youth mobility programs, such as *Tremplin Jeunes*, in the non-formal education field.
- **Young people from Belgium** between 18 and 35 years old, interested in participating in a volunteering experience abroad while improving their knowledge of another language and acquiring new professional and personal skills.

A step by step project:

- **The young participants** will be responsible for their own project. They will contact you directly to apply for a volunteer work within your association. If it's ok with you, they will apply for a grant from the BIJ
- **The BIJ** will form an evaluation committee and will fund the selected projects.
- **You** have to arrange the volunteer work/internship with the young participant.

Your obligations:

- To sign a commitment letter with the volunteer specifying his/her tasks, the dates and schedules and the conditions of the project (i.e. paid or not)
- To host the selected participant, advise and provide him/her with the necessary support for personal and professional integration.
- No financial support is mandatory, nevertheless any help would be welcome in order to reward the commitment and work of the volunteer.
